- WHEREAS:** Jimmy Driftwood sang, the Buffalo is "*Arkansas's gift to the nation and America's gift the world*", and
- WHEREAS:** the beautiful Buffalo River has been threatened in the past but thanks to the hard work and commitment of the Ozark Society, it remains one of the very few free-flowing streams in the lower-48 states, and
- WHEREAS:** we as citizens of Fayetteville are here tonight to celebrate this treasure and to call for continued action to help preserve this magnificent stream, and
- WHEREAS:** efforts to preserve the Buffalo River began here in Fayetteville 55 years ago and continue today as we again join in support of the Buffalo River Watershed Alliance to continue the work to again save the Buffalo.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Lioneld Jordan, Mayor of the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas do hereby proclaim January 29, 2017 as

"BUFFALO NATIONAL RIVER PRESERVATION AND APPRECIATION DAY"
